



#### Challenges

- There were more respondents than expected, the plan was 4-5 people per sub group but what happened was there were around 7-8 people per subgroup.
- There wasn't enough time or rather the people were getting impatient and so we had to shorten the program a bit.
- Conflict of instructions, the other group was given a different set of instructions from ours which cost us quite a bit of time in the planning and development of the program.
- There were not enough pens, and markers for people to write on their metacards.
- Other sub-groups deviated from the plan.

- Preferably we should have been flexible with the program but what happened was that we still ended up pushing through it despite the annoyances expressed by the respondents and the community.
- Another thing would be that there was a communication barrier between the Dutch students and the community which required a need for a translator or mediator which made facilitating the people even more difficult and consumed quite a bit of time in order to properly get the point across.
- The interview questions felt a bit too stiff.

#### **Experience and Insights Gained**

- One of the experiences that we gained is that the program should have been flexible according to the reactions of the community or whenever the correspondents show discomfort especially when probing intrusive questions into their personal life.
- The community presented a lot of problems but the most prevalent of them all was the smell of the river which can then be attributed to the garbage present in the river.
- One should always be casual and should prevent exerting an intimidating mood caused by being stiff or awkward and talking in a different accent and language. This can be prevented by engaging in casual conversation, and constantly engaging with them by not making them feel like they are being interviewed but rather engaging in a casual discussion with a concerned friend or an acquaintance, to let them feel the human within you.
- Seeing the situation of the community, we could say that the real world is really harsh and unfair. We are very privileged to live a more comfortable life than them and that we should not take this for granted, but instead we should lend a helping hand to the struggling community.
